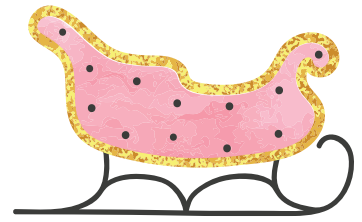




# Christmas Cleaning & Organising Calendar
